Tour Itinerary

Day 1:

Arrive at the airport in the morning and travel to Zakopane. Check into your apartment. There are no scheduled tours on this day, but there are many famous restaurants near the apartment

Day 2:

Head to a river 13 kilometers from the Polish-Slovak border for a two-hour rafting trip with a guide.

Day 3:

Take a trip to Lake Morskie Oko ("Eye of the Sea") and enjoy a 20-kilometer round-trip horse ride.

Day 4:

Choose to visit either the main square in Krakow or an amusement park.

Day 5:

Travel to the glass train high in the mountains, where you can find shops and games, including a summer toboggan run. You will also visit the main shopping street and the Upside-Down House. There will be no car on this day as the accommodation is close to the tourist sites. The trip is expected to last 6 hours.

Day 6:

Take a cable car ride to the mountain peak for a high-altitude view of the mountains and visit the waterfalls. A car will take you to the cable car location, which is about 10 minutes from your accommodation.

Day 7:

Free time to explore the city. There is no car provided on this day as the accommodation is near the

tourist sites.
